Report by District Councillor Tom Howard

Local Plan

The long overdue Local Plan has now been further delayed following significant objections from Colchester Borough Council and Essex County Council. These objections need to be dealt with and the Local Plan further amended before it can be submitted to the Planning Inspector.

This is likely to push the eventual adoption of the Local Plan out to late 2015 or even early 2016 - which would then be 5 years late!

Tendring District Council have set up a Local Plan Committee to look at the objections and issues that need to be addressed and help produce a revised Local Plan that will be acceptable to the Planning Inspector.

I have been appointed to that committee on behalf of the Independent Group.

International Women's Cycle Race

As you are probably aware by now from various press releases, there is an International Women's Cycle Race passing through Tendring for 2 days in May. The first day will be May 9th,

The second day will be May 11th where it will be go from Harwich to Bury St Edmunds on the same day as the annual Tour de Tendring Cycle event.
